Does not take risks

When working with an Owl, you may need to...

Give them details
Present facts
Present the logic behind your thoughts
Pose problems for them to solve

Eagles are...

Decisive, tough
Strong willed
Competitive, Demanding
Independent, Self Confident

but can be perceived as...

Aggressive, blunt Self-Centred Overbearing Exceeds Authority

When working with an Eagle, you may need to...

Let them think it's their idea Let them change things a little Stick to the facts Let them execute tasks

SENSING

Doves are...

Calm, steady Careful, patient Good listener Modest, trustworthy

but can be perceived as...

Resists new ideas
Does not express
Stubborn
Does not seek change

When working with a Dove, you may need to...

Give them time to think
Give them time to ask questions
Not rush them

INTUITION

Peacocks are...

Sociable Talkative, open Enthusiastic, energetic Persuasive

but can be perceived as...

Flamboyant, frantic Careless, indiscreet Excitable, hasty Loses sense of time

When working with a Peacock, you may need to...

Let them talk about it with you and others Be enthusiastic Not expect too much detail

- · Being able to connect with people in a different way to what you're used to
